Join fellow conservationists to hear about innovative water quality efforts in Indiana

Water Quality Trading—Water quality trading is an innovative market-based approach to achieving water quality goals for the reduction of nutrients such as phosphorus and nitrogen through programs that allow permitted emitters to purchase nutrient reductions from another source. Find out what farmers are doing to earn conservation credits in southeast Indiana.

Drainage Water Management—Producers know there is either too much water or not enough. They are looking for ways to control water; to fine-tune water delivery on their terms. DWM practices manage the timing and amount of water discharged from agricultural drainage systems and can reduce excess nutrients—nitrates and phosphorous—that ultimately enter creeks and streams through tile drain water and negatively impact the environment.

Speakers include **Jessica Fox**, Program Manager at the Electric Power Research Institute (EPRI); **Brian Brandt**, Director, Agricultural Conservation Innovations Center, American Farmland Trust; **Nathan Utt**, Lead Engineer, Ecosystems Services Exchange; and **Tara Wessler**, District Support Specialist, Indiana State Department of Agriculture.
